<sup>1</sup>Beginning in Fall 2017, SAT scores reported consist of two sections: (1) evidence-based reading and writing and (2) math with a total of 800 potential points per section and a maximum score of 1600 points on the overall test. This replaced the 2400 point scale prior to 2016. <sup>2</sup>A small number of Nonresident students are included within the Associate in Arts Program averages.

<sup>3</sup>Source for National Average is The College Board (www.collegeboard.org). The national combined SAT average is 1060 and represents the sum of the EBRW and Math national averages may not add up to the national combined average due to rounding.

<sup>4</sup>The average "Total SAT EBRW and Math Scores" are calculated by first summing each student's highest scores on the EBRW and Math tests and then finding the average of this total score for all students.

Notes: Converted ACT scores are not included with SAT scores. UD accepts self-reported scores for admissions review. As such, not all scores are verified. Applicants for Fall 2023 were not required to submit standardized test scores. For Fall 2023, a total of 1597 Newark Campus students (442 Delawareans; 1155 Nonresidents) submitted SAT scores.

Starting in Fall 2023, fall admissions activity includes first-time first-year students whose application term is the preceding summer. Applicants and admissions data reflects report run date of October 24, 2023. Enrollment data reflects report run on the 10th day of the Fall 2023 semester.
